1.0 Information Brief - Modern Apprenticeship SCQF 6 Agriculture GR6E 23

Modern Apprenticeships in Agriculture (SCQF 6) typically take around 12- 18 months to complete. Whilst undertaking the Modern Apprenticeship, you will have on farm assessments to complete.

Start dates may vary. Whether you are leaving school, in current employment, seeking an apprenticeship, an employer, a careers adviser or are a parent or carer, in the first instance, please contact Tarff Services Service Coordinator.

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As a Modern Apprentice in Agriculture, you will be employed within the Agricultural sector and study part time to reach the standards set by the Scottish Qualifications Authority (SQA). You will cover a range of topics and complete on farm assessments to show competence in specific tasks. You will also complete a variety of workbooks to show/develop underpinning knowledge within the framework.
